ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral)

Vide order dated 27.04.2023, passed by this Court in an earlier petition filed by the petitioner (CWP-8739-2023), the matter was disposed of, on the assurance given by the learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 4 (PGIMER) that in the event the petitioner submits a representation to the authorities qua its concerns/grievances, the same shall be considered and dealt with. And appropriate orders shall be passed thereon as far as possible within a period of one week thereafter.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner, thereafter, submitted a representation on 01.05.2023, and the authorities were even served with a legal notice dated 28.05.2023. But, the matter has not made any tangible progress. Thus, he asserts that there is apparent breach of the assurance/undertaking submitted on behalf of the respondents for timely

decision upon the representation of the petitioner. And, appropriate proceedings/orders are required to be passed against them.

Upon being served with the advance copy of the petition, Ms. Amarjeet Kaur, learned counsel for the respondent (PGIMER), is present in Court. She submits that the Director, PGIMER, is already in seisin of the matter and appropriate order, in accordance with law, shall be passed upon the representation submitted by the petitioner within a week from today. She assures that till the time such orders are passed, the work as regards the supply of Liquid Medical Oxygen (LMO) shall not be assigned pursuant to NIT dated 17.11.2022.

In the wake of the above, the petition is disposed of, in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties. This Court is sanguine that the authorities shall pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law, as indicated above.
