Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.152 dated 26.12.2016 registered under Sections 420, 34 IPC at Police Station Division No.2, District Pathankot.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that in light of previous order, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police. State counsel on instructions from ASI Vimal has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation as the main accused Mangat Ram Saini husband of the petitioner stands arrested in this case.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 14.7.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
