The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.627 dated 23.06.2022 registered under Sections 21(b) and 27-A of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station HTM Hisar, District Hisar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 14.07.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. He further contends that so far the CDRs are concerned, in the absence of the contents of the conversation, the said CDRs do not further the case of the prosecution.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 14.07.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
