JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

Through instant petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Code, 1973, the petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.08 dated 03.07.2019 (Annexure P-1) registered at Police Station Dhar Kalan, District Pathankot, under Sections 366, 376, 420, 466, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

On 17.10.2022, this Court has passed the following order:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.2 is married with daughter of complainant-respondent No.2. He also submits that as on date, both are major and they are parents of one child.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jagdish Singh, has submitted that petitioner No.2 has been declared Proclaimed Offender on 05.10.2019. He has also submitted that the petitioner No.2 and the victim are not traceable and it is because of the same, the prosecutrix could not be examined by the trial Court till date.

On request of learned counsel for respondent No.2, adjourned to 01.02.2023.”

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 submit that they are not having contact with their respective clients, thus, they are unable to assist the Court and address arguments.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of at this stage with liberty to parties to move an appropriate application, if something survives.
