SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

1. By way of present writ petition, petitioners have approached this Court *inter alia* seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to consider and decide representations dated 19.04.2023 and 15.05.2023, Annexures P-4 and P-5, respectively, moved by the petitioners.

2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that Sh. Gurdev Singh, father of the petitioners, was working as a Assistant Sub Inspector on regular basis in the Haryana Police and he unfortunately expired on 13.01.2023 during his service tenure. Counsel submits that despite the fact that the Government of Haryana has framed Haryana Civil Services (Compassionate Financial Assistance or Appointment) Rules, 2019, the heirs of the deceased have neither received the ex-gratia compensation nor have they been offered

appointment on compassionate basis. Counsel submits that petitioners have submitted representations, Annexures P-4 and P-5, but to no avail and the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to look into them.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
5. Having heard counsel for the parties, but without calling for a return or commenting upon the grievance of the petitioners, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the representation, Annexure P-5, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
6. In case, respondent No.2 is unable to accede to the representation of the petitioners, an order be passed assigning reasons for rejection.
