SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (Oral)

1. The writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat concerned, to forthwith draw a petition under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 before the Collector concerned, for thereby seeking the eviction of the encroachers upon the disputed lands. However, prior to the institution of the said petition, a valid demarcation by the competent Revenue Officer shall be made on the disputed lands and only if the demarcation report speaks about the encroachment(s) being made upon the disputed lands, thus eviction petition (supra), shall be preferred before the Collector concerned.
2. On such a petition being instituted before the Collector concerned, the latter shall make lawful speaking orders thereons but after hearing all affected persons.
