The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus seeking directions to the respondents to decide the complaint and application of the petitioner (Annexures P-5 and P-6) by passing speaking orders and taking necessary legal action in the matter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of her grievances petitioner had already filed a complaint dated 17.4.2023 (Annexure P-5), however, no action has been taken thereon till date. It is submitted that report of the Forensic Expert has been received on 9.5.2023 substantiating contentions of the petitioner, however, the same was received after filing of the complaint dated 17.4.2023 and hence the same could not be appended with the same. Counsel submits that she would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to decide the complaint of the petitioner dated 17.4.2023 (Annexure P-5) by taking into consideration the report of the Forensic Expert (Annexure P-7).

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kirpal Singh, A.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3.

In view of the above position, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority i.e. respondent no.2 to decide the complaint filed by the petitioner dated 17.4.2023 (Annexure P-5) by taking into consideration the report of Forensic Expert (Annexure P-7), within a period of one month from today in accordance with law.
