SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

1. By way of present writ petition, petitioner has challenged impugned order dated 23.05.2023, Annexure P-1, whereby petitioner, who is working as a Staff Nurse, has been transferred from PHC, Madhogarh, District Mahendragarh to PHC Deeghot, District Palwal.
2. By referring to the medical reports appended as Annexure P-3, counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner's mother-in-law underwent a bypass surgery in 2019 and has not fully recovered. He submits that petitioner's transfer to Palwal, which is at a distance of 148 kms, will disrupt her family life as her son has joined B.Sc. at Mahendragarh and has deposited the requisite fee.
3. Heard counsel for the petitioner.

4. Transfer is an exigency of service. Scope for interference with a transfer order is very limited. Every transfer order is bound to cause some hardship or inconvenience to an employee, but that cannot be the sole ground to set it aside. Moreover, petitioner has been continuing at PHC, Madhogarh, District Mahendragarh, since August 2014. She cannot insist that she should be allowed to continue at the same place.
5. There is no merit in the writ petition, which is hereby dismissed.
