In the present petitions, the petitioners are claiming benefit of appointment on the post of clerk in pursuance to the advertisement No.10/2015 (Annexure P/1) against the posts which are lying vacant qua the EBPG category for which, the petitioners were competing and their names were in the waiting list and the Chief Secretary is to decide their claim with regard to the posts, which are lying vacant keeping in view the fact that petitioners are within the zone of merit qua the posts for which they were competing.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioners will be considered by the authority concerned in case there is no impediment in considering the same coupled with the settled principle of law settled by this Court in **CWP-16988-2014** titled as **Suman Rani vs. State of Haryana and others** decided on 22.09.2016, an appropriate order on the claim of the petitioners will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case after the decision, the petitioners are found entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to them within a period of next four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, present petitions may kindly be

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disposed of having been not pressed any further.
