Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the impugned letter dated 09.08.2022 (Annexure P-6), vide which the claim of the petitioners has been rejected. The petitioners also seeks quashing the action of the respondents in not correcting the zones and not updating the same on MIS Profiles of the petitioners in accordance with the Notification dated 23.06.2017 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been working as Post Graduate Teachers in Zone Nos.5 and 6; that the respondent-department is not opening the portal as per the Notification dated 23.06.2017 (Annexure P-4) and that the prayer of the petitioners is for rectification of zones as per the Transfer Policy, 2016 i.e. from zone No.2 to Zone No.5/6.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised their grievance before the

respondents by way of filing a representation dated 22.09.2022 (Annexure P-7), which are still pending consideration. It is further submitted that the petitioners will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. R.S. Budhwar, Addl. AG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submits that he has no objection in case, the directions for deciding the representation aforesaid, are issued.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.2-Director General, Department of Secondary Education, Haryana, is directed to decide the representation dated 22.09.2022 (Annexure P-7) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
