ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 7 & 9 submits that the order dated 13.07.2021 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Patti, in CS/67/2021, vide which application under Order 39 Rules 1 & 2 CPC was dismissed and thereafter, the appeal filed against the said order was also dismissed and later on, the suit was also dismissed for non-prosecution on 22.02.2023. It is further submitted that the Panchayat has taken the possession, in accordance with law.

In the affidavit of Incharge, Police Post Toot, Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran, a similar stand is taken and it is stated that BDPO, Patti, District Tarn Taran, on 24.07.2023, requested to provide police help for removing the illegal occupation from the shamlat land of Village Patti Kila and the police acted in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is rendered as infructuous.
