By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.43 dated 28.02.2023 registered under Section 406, 34 IPC at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

As it was informed that there were chances of compromise, so the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and till then arrest of the petitioner was stayed. The report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre has been received, as per which, matter has been amicably settled between the parties. Copy of settlement deed is also placed on record.

The settlement is admitted by learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, present petition is allowed. The petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail. Therefore, it is directed that in case of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioner shall join the

investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
