1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 15.11.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2 and order dated 22.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) passed by the appellate authority, vide which, the application of petitioner filed under Section 23 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents & Senior Citizen Act, 2007 has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per his instructions, the petitioner had died and the present writ petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, but prayed that the liberty be granted to the legal representatives of the petitioner to revive the present case in case any cause survives.

3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

4. Liberty is granted to the legal representatives of the petitioner to move an application for revival of the present petition in case any cause survives.
