The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0065 dated 31.03.2023 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 01.06.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

As the case is arising out of a matrimonial dispute, no case for custodial interrogation is made out.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 01.06.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
