1. Learned counsel for the parties submit that the parties have already compromised their dispute, according to which, appellants will pay a sum of ₹60,000/- so that the litigation, which is between the family itself comes to an end.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that keeping in view the instructions received from the respondent, who is also present in Court, the said offer is acceptable and the present appeal may kindly be disposed of in terms of the compromise as recorded above.

3. Keeping in view the compromise between the parties, who are present in the Court and the statement of learned counsel for the appellants that the appellants will pay a sum of ₹60,000/- by 30.06.2023 in favour of the respondent so as to end the litigation between the parties. By exercising powers under Order 23 Rule 3 of CPC, the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the compromise recorded hereinbefore.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the appellants submits that as the present appeal has been disposed of on the basis of the compromise, the

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Court fee deposited may kindly be refunded.

5. Keeping in view the settled principle of law on the said issue, Registry is directed to refund the court fee deposited by the appellants, in case any such application is moved by the appellants.
