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**N.S. SHEKHAWAT, J. (ORAL)**

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his mother and not to harass them.

2. Further prayer was made to direct the respondents no.1 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in the case arising out of FIR No. 06 dated 24.01.2023 under Section 21 of ND&PS Act, 1985 at Police Station Kathgarh, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is residing along with his mother namely Jyoti Devi at the address mentioned in the head note of the petition. Keshav, brother of the petitioner is working in Punjab Water Resource and Development Nigam Limited, Ropar (Punjab) and is taking care of both the petitioner and their mother. Learned counsel

further contends that one FIR No.06 dated 24.01.2023 under Section 21 of ND&PS Act, 1985 at Police Station Kathgarh has been registered against Gagandeep Singh @Gagan and later on Keshav has also been arrayed as an accused in the present case.

4. Learned counsel further contends that the police is now harassing the petitioner and his mother without any justification. Even Keshav, brother of the petitioner has nothing to do with this case and has been falsely implicated at the behest of some local politicians.

5. A short reply by way of affidavit of Sham Sunder Sharma, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Balachaur, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

6. Learned State counsel submits that the investigation in case FIR No.06 dated 24.01.2023 under Section 21 of ND&PS Act, 1985 has been conducted fairly and Keshav, brother of the petitioner has been found involved in the said FIR and house of the petitioner was raided to search the accused-Keshav in the said house.

7. Learned State counsel further submits that during the course of investigation, the involvement of the petitioner and his mother has not been found in the said crime, at this stage.

8. Learned State counsel further submits that neither the petitioner nor his mother have been harassed by the Investigating Agency and in case, their involvement is found at any stage of investigation, appropriate action shall be taken after following the procedure established by the law.

9. Learned State counsel further submits that even the petitioner and his mother will not be unnecessarily harassed in the present case and in case, they are required to be joined in the investigation, a notice in writing shall be issued to both of them.

10. In view of the assurance given by the learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the petition is accordingly disposed of.
