SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., *inter alia* for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to decide the representation dated 23.05.2023 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) at an earlier point of time regarding theft of his tractor-trolley by the private respondent. She submits that when no action was taken, petitioner approached the Court under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. She submits that petitioner was forced to enter into a compromise, but tractor-trolley has still not been returned. She submits that the petitioner had moved a fresh representation, Annexure P-1, which is pending and the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to look into the same.

3. Notice of motion restricted to official respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Gupta, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on their behalf.
5. Having heard counsel for the parties, but without examining the allegations as levelled in the petition or in the representations, petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hisar-respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 23.05.2023 (Annexure P-1) within a period of four months from the date of communication of copy of this order and to take further action thereon as warranted in accordance with law.
