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The prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.58, dated 08.03.2022 under Sections 147, 149, 186, 332, 353, 341, 427, 506 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Nangal Chaudhary, District Mahendergarh, Haryana.

On 02.08.2022, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated and he was only the owner of the vehicle which was allegedly having overload of stones and minerals. He further submitted that even if the vehicle had hit the Government vehicle but the same was not intentional.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ranvir Singh Arya, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State and prays for some time to file affidavit. Adjourned to 30.01.2023.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and on his doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bond and surety to the

satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Reply, if any, be filed on or before the next date of hearing with an advance copy to the learned counsel for the petitioner. ”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jai Bhagwan submits that in compliance of the order dated 02.08.2022, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is not required for any custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 02.08.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
