This petition was filed for setting aside letter dated 08.09.2020 (P-6) and communication dated 29.09.2020 as well as agreement/tender for supply of manpower to Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority, dated 29.09.2020 (P-11), which has been awarded to respondent No.7 in violation of the terms and conditions of the Detail Notice Inviting Tender (DNIT).

On the previous date of hearing, i.e., 14.12.2022, taking note of the fact that the contract period is already over, the petition was about to be dismissed as infructuous. However, at that stage, learned counsel for the petitioner stated that as per information the contract of respondent No.7 had been extended by the respondent-authorities and their cause of action still survives.

Today, learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the State of Haryana has placed before this Court order dated 24.01.2023, vide which the contract awarded to respondent No.7 has been terminated and

come to an end w.e.f. 31.12.2022. Therefore, as on day, nothing further survives for adjudication in the petition.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. However, the petitioner would be entitled to avail other remedies available to it under the common law, if so advised.
