Applicants-petitioners pray for placing on record amended memo of parties after carrying out typographical mistakes occurred in the name of petitioner No.2 and in the name of his father.

Notice of the application.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sanish Girdhar, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submits that he has no objection in case the present application is accepted.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Amended memo of parties is permitted to be placed on record.

Main case

This order shall dispose of afore-mentioned two petitions as both of them have arisen out of the same FIR.

The petitioners have filed these petitions under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.35 dated 13.03.2023 registered under Sections 323/324/326/506/148/149 at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana Rural.

During the course of hearing on 02.08.2023, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Both the parties appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre and signed a compromise/settlement dated 25.08.2023.

Today, both the parties are present in the Court.

Learned counsel for both the parties, on instructions from their respective clients, submit that both the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise/settlement dated 25.08.2023.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the parties, both these petitions stand allowed. The interim orders dated 02.06.2023 and 06.06.2023 are made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
