1. Heard.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that FIR No.17 dated 11.02.2023, under Sections 307, 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC, registered at P.S. Division, D-Police Commissionerate Amritsar, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) was got registered by the complainant-Sunny Kumar, son of the petitioner. But no action has been taken on the said FIR in question.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner has also moved a representation dated *nil* to respondent No. 3-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar. But the concerned authorities has not taken any action on the said representation. He has also placed on record the postal receipts dated 17.05.2023 in this regard.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Shubham Kaushik, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State-

respondents No. 1 to 4.

In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to consider the averments made in the representation (Annexure P-2), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
