1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC seeking issuance of directions to official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take appropriate action against respondent No.4-Sub Inspector Jagbir Singh, P.S. Kot Khalsa, Amritsar, who has been unnecessarily intimidating and threatening the petitioner's son and her family members regarding foisting some false case.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent Nos.1 to 3.

4. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-1) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner through registry on 24.05.2023 seeking protection for her son and her family members.

5. Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be

dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
