1. In the present petition, prayer of the petitioner is that services of the husband of the petitioner, who unfortunately died, should be regularized w.e.f. 01.02.1996 instead of 01.10.2003.

2. On being pointed out as to why the present petition has been filed after a period of 18 years of the order regularizing the services of the husband of the petitioner from 01.10.2003 was passed, no justification has come forward. Further, husband of the petitioner died in the year 2018 and after a period of 03 years, the present petition has been filed.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further but liberty be given to the petitioner to approach the respondents by way of filing a representation especially when similarly

situated employees as the husband of the petitioner, have been regularized in service w.e.f. 01.02.1996.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner, same will be decided in accordance with law keeping in view the service record of the husband of the petitioner and appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of any such representation.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

6. Ordered accordingly.
