The present case pertains to the appointment for the post of Aaganwari workers.

In terms of the Scheme of Rules, there is an appeal provided against the orders aggrieved, to the Collector, then to the Commissioner and then to the Secretary. Accordingly, the petitioner is at liberty to file an appeal before the Collector.

If such an appeal is filed, the same shall be heard and decided by the Collector expeditiously and preferably within a period of two months from today. Further, the petitioner is still aggrieved, it is always open for her to approach the higher Appellate Courts as noticed above. The appeal shall be decided on merits without dealing on the question of limitation. Counsel for the respondent shall also be given opportunity of hearing.

The present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
