This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing/setting aside the order dated 06.06.2011 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Hoshiarpur and order dated 07.12.2016 passed by the Commissioner (Appeals), Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar as well as the order dated 02.08.2018 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Financial Commissioner (Appeal) Punjab, whereby the mode of partition has been ordered and upheld.
