VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the letter dated 26.10.2010 (Annexure P-10) passed by respondent No.5 declining to give the fee waiver to the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents have submitted that since, the present writ petition is of the year 2010 and the petitioner has completed the course thus, the present Civil Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that she does not have any instructions regarding the same and submits that the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty be granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case in case, any cause survives to her.

4. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

5. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to her.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
