Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.81 dated 19.06.2021, under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar Rural.

Vide order dated 25.01.2023, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 25.01.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljit Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is

no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 25.01.2023 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
