Application under Section 482 Cr.PC for correction in the head note and in the prayer clause of the main petition by adding offence under Section 201 IPC, has been filed.

Notice in the application.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and he has no objection to the prayer made therein.

Consequently, application is allowed and office is directed to do the needful at appropriate places.

CRM stands disposed of.

Main case

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.118 dated 04.06.2022, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 201, 365, 342, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC.

Vide order dated 18.07.2022 while granting interim protection, the

petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 18.07.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer and interim order dated 18.07.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
