1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the impugned order dated 26.02.2019 (Annexure P-1), vide which the petitioner has been ordered to vacate the house of respondent No.1 within a period of 30 days.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that respondent No.1 has died and in all probability, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous, but however, he is not in touch with the present petitioner. It is prayed that in view of the said fact, the present writ petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous and has further prayed that liberty be granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration or to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.

3. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

4. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present petition or to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.
