The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, praying for issuance of direction to respondents No. 1 to 4, to take legal action against respondents No. 5 to 7 for defrauding the petitioner to the tune of Rs.30,00,000/- in connivance and in conspiracy with each other on the basis of impersonation by forging the false documents and using the same as genuine and for advancing threats to the petitioner to implicate him in false cases/complaints if the petitioner dare to proceed against them.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that he be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to avail alternate and appropriate remedy, in accordance with law.
