Petitioner seeks issuance of appropriate directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 for taking strict legal action against respondent Nos.4 to 7 and further to hand-over the inquiry/investigation of the case to some superior/competent authority, as she and her husband are being harassed by being summoned to police station without their being any case against them.

2. Earlier the matter was taken up on 02.06.2023 when the then learned State counsel appearing had sought time to get instructions *qua* the averments contained in the petition and to file reply in matter.

3. On resumed hearing today, learned State counsel under instructions from SI Jagtar Singh, states that it was pursuant to a police complaint filed by ex father-in-law of the petitioner from her first marriage, the concerned police official had asked her to come to the police station along with her current husband. He submits that subsequently, on further inquiry, it turned out that no action was required on the aforesaid complaint

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and the same has now been recommended to be filed. Being so, he submits complaint is thus likely to be eventually filed. In the premise, petitioner and her husband would no more be required to come to the police station **in the said complaint.**

4. In view of the aforesaid, it appears that the apprehension of the petitioner already stands allayed. No further proceedings are required before this Court.
5. Disposed of.
6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
