NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.PC for issuance of direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and for directing the official respondents to give advance notice in writing under Section 160 Cr.PC, in case the petitioner is required in connection with the complaint No.1179-COP dated 06.03.2019 given by the respondent No.5 and for directing the respondent No.2 to ensure that the inquiry of the said complaint is carried out in a fair and impartial manner after hearing the petitioner and considering the documentary as well as the oral evidence.

In pursuance of notice of motion, status report dated 22.10.2019 by way of affidavit of Sarbjit Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, North Amritsar on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 had been filed and in para Nos.5 and 6 thereof the following averments have been made:-

“5. That it is humbly submitted that during the course of enquiry conducted into the above applications, with the intervention of respectable persons, the applicant/respondent No.5, Varundeep Mehta and other party namely Ramesh Kumar, Sanjeev Kumar, Rajiv Kumar Sehgal and Sanjay

Sehgal have effected compromise on 17.06.2019 with respect to the application given by Varundeep Mehta (Respondent No.5), which was produced before the enquiry officer i.e. In-charge of Police Post Circuit House, Amritsar by him while producing the compromise and recording his statement from him in this regard. The compromise and statement of Varundeep Mehta are annexed here with as Annexure R-1/T & R-2/T for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court.

6. That it is humbly submitted that as the applicant/respondent No.5, Varundeep Mehta has effected compromise with other party namely Ramesh Kumar, Sanjeev Kumar Sehgal, Rajiv Kumar Sehgal and Sanjay Sehgal and has recorded his statement that his application may be consigned and he would file separate application as for as the dispute with the present petitioner is concerned. Therefore, the applications of both the parties have been consigned to record. As such, at present no application is pending either against the petitioner or given by the petitioner. The enquiry report submitted in this regard is annexed herewith as Annexure R-3/T for the kind perusal of this Hon'ble Court. ”

From the reproduction made above, it is clear that respondent No.5 Varundeep Mehta made a statement that he has compromised the matter with other party namely Ramesh Kumar, Sanjeev Kumar Sehgal, Rajiv Kumar Sehgal and Sanjay Sehgal and has also recorded his statement that his application may be consigned and he would file separate application as far as the dispute with the present petitioner is concerned.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
