No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

On 03.07.2019, the following order was passed.

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over Rs. 20,000/- in cash to the respondent-Pawan Chaudhary and the same is duly acknowledged by the respondent, who is present in Court and he is identified by his counsel.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks some time to deposit Rs.10,000/- as litigation expenses in favour of High Court Legal Service Authority.

Adjourned to 29.07.2019”.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that the matter had been settled between the parties and the entire amount had been repaid to the respondent.

Only a sum of ₹10,000/- remained to be deposited as litigation expenses in favour of High Court Legal Services Authority.

The noting on the file shows that the amount of ₹10,000/- was deposited in cash and deposit order was ordered to be issued by the office.

In view of the aforesaid facts, the present revision petition is allowed. The judgment dated 25.10.2017 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali and judgment dated 17.01.2017, passed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar, Mohali, are set aside and the petitioner is acquitted.
