HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner (Kanwaljit Singh @ Kamaljit Singh) has filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for setting aside a part of award dated 28.01.2014 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.1 – the Presiding Officer, Industrial Tribunal, Patiala, whereby relief of reinstatement with all consequential benefits has been declined to the petitioner-workman. A further prayer has been made to direct the respondents to reinstate the petitioner with continuity of service and all consequential benefits as well as the back wages.

2. A perusal of file reveals that on 12.07.2022, when learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner had prayed for an adjournment

then it was clarified that no further adjournment shall be granted for any reason whatsoever.

3. Today, the matter has been called twice since morning, however, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant matter any further.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
