On 29.07.2022, the following order was passed:

“Second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been filed for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.0074 dated 14.05.2022, registered under Sections 452, 323, 326, 379-B, 380, 427, 506, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Sadar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib. The first one had been dismissed on 14.06.2022 by recording as under:-

“The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0074, dated 14.05.2022, registered under Sections 452, 323, 326, 379-B, 380, 427, 506, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Sadar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The petitioner is a close relation of the daughter-in-law of the complainant and the dispute is on account of inheritance as such. Admittedly, there is a medical report (Annexure P-2) regarding grievous injury on right leg including three other injuries on the person of complainant Karnail Singh, who is aged 65 years.

Keeping in view the above and also the fact that the injured was assaulted in the house of his brother, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is hereby dismissed.”

It has been brought to the notice of the undersigned that the father of the present petitioner namely Gurcharan Singh was granted the benefit of anticipatory bail in CRM-M-25953-2022 on 07.06.2022 and which has further been confirmed on 20.07.2022. It is further submitted a compromise has been arrived on account of close relation *inter se* the parties. Even a quashing petition had been filed, which however has been withdrawn on account of typographical errors and a fresh one is likely to be filed.

Accordingly, notice of motion be issued for 14.10.2022.

Mr. Abhaypal Singh Gill, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In the meantime, it is directed that the petitioner shall join investigation and in the event of arrest, he shall be released on *ad interim* bail by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when required and shall comply with the conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

2. Today, the State Counsel on instructions from ASI Amritpal Singh, Police Station Sadar Shri Muktsar Sahib, submits that the cancellation report in the present case has been submitted on 03.06.2023 on the basis of a compromise and therefore the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

3. In view of the above statement, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the order dated 29.07.2022 is hereby confirmed.
