

SUKHWINDER SINGH SIDHU VS PRITAM SINGH ETC.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel and representative of the respondent –Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.80,000/- (Rupees Eighty thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant as full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant within a period of six weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the respondent/Insurance Company submits that the amount of Rs.80,000/- shall be deposited with the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Moga/Executing Court within a period of 6 weeks from today.

Accordingly, we dispose of this appeal with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.80,000/- in the name of appellant with the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Moga/Executing Court within a period of 6 weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount, till payment from the date of this order.

In the event, if the appellant/claimant is no longer available for any

reason including the one that he has expired, then his legal representatives are entitled to withdraw the amount from the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Moga/Executing Court in equal share on making an appropriate application, which shall be decided by the Tribunal/Executing Court at the earliest.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
