1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents not to do any illegal demolition in the property of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that with respect to the grievance of the petitioner, a representation dated 29.05.2023 (Annexure P-11) has been given by the petitioner to the Municipal Commissioner and the petitioner would be satisfied in case the Municipal Commissioner considers the representation in a time bound manner and in case the Municipal Commissioner finds that the plea raised by the petitioner is meritorious, then necessary relief be granted to the petitioner.

submitted that they would consider the representation (Annexure P-11), in accordance with law.

4. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Municipal Commissioner, Amritsar to consider the representation (Annexure P-11) within a period of one month from today and after considering the said representation in case, the Municipal Commissioner is of the opinion that the pleas raised by the petitioner are meritorious, then necessary relief, in accordance with law, be granted to the petitioner. In case, the Municipal Commissioner is of the opinion that pleas raised by the petitioner are meritless, then the same be rejected by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from today.

5. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and the Municipal Commissioner would consider the representation independently, in accordance with law.
