The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case registered vide FIR No.80 dated 20.05.2023 under Sections 21 & 22 of the NDPS Act and Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act registered at P.S. Sadar, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 02.06.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 02.06.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 02.06.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation

as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
