The instant writ petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to pay rent as assessed by the Competent Authority.

Reply by way of affidavit of Parmdeep Singh, Under Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice, on behalf of respondent No.1 as well as reply by way of affidavit of Navjot Pal Singh Randhawa, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4, filed today in the Court are taken on record. Copies thereof have been furnished to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

It has been averred in the aforesaid reply that the outstanding rent of the premises has already been released to the Panchayat Samiti in compliance of the orders passed by this Court. A similar averment has also been made in the affidavit dated 06.04.2023 filed by the Deputy Commissioner, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

In view of the aforesaid, it is thus contended that all arrears after 28.02.2023 have already been cleared.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the aforesaid factual aspect, however, he has prayed that future rent may be released without any default.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr.Kulwinder Singh, Reader to Tehsildar, Nawanshahr (Deputy Commissioner Office, S.B.S. Nagar) and Mr. Gurjant Singh, Sr. Assistant (Department of Home Affairs and Justice), submits that there would be no further default in release of the subsequent rent as well.

In view of aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

Disposed of as not pressed.
