1. Pursuant to order passed by this Court, report has been received from learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rewari, which is reproduced as under:-

“It is humbly submitted that vide order dated 18.07.2023 the Trial court has been directed to submit the report in the matter. In the present case the protest petition has been filed by the complainant DSP Virender Singh on 04.02.2020 and the same was adjourned for 22.05.2020 for preliminary evidence of complainant and thereafter, neither the complainant appeared in the court nor any witness has been examined by the complainant. Learned counsel for the complainant sought adjournments on each and every date in a casual manner. On 25.08.2023 non (sic none) has appeared on behalf of complainant. Hence the present complaint was dismissed for non prosecution and the file was ordered to be consigned to the record room.”

2. In view of the above development, prayer made in the petition has become infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the petition in case the occasion so arises.

3. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous with liberty as aforesaid.
