The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.61, dated 15.05.2022, under Sections 306, 34 of the IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Mullanpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Considering the submissions made by the respective counsels, the interim bail was granted vide order dated 20.07.2022 and subsequently which was extended from time to time and lastly on 14.10.2022, the learned State counsel had sought one more opportunity to get compared the specimen signatures, which has now been obtained by Investigating Agency with the signatures of the accused.

This Court vide order dated 20.07.2022, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to her joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the

order dated 20.07.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the order dated 20.07.2022 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
