Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that vide order dated 14.11.2022, the petitioner was granted concession of interim anticipatory bail.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that parties were directed to appear before Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. The parties have settled their all disputes and have filed petition under Section 13B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, seeking divorce by mutual consent. The petitioner has filed petition before this Court i.e. CRM-M-49861-2022, seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Subhash Raj submits that petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim protection granted to the petitioner vide order dated 14.11.2022 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.
