Present writ petition has been filed for quashing the letter/ order dated 20.08.2020 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.4 calling upon the petitioner Gram Panchayat to return the amount of Rs.8 lakhs along with interest immediately and ordered the Gram Panchayat to deposit the amount into the bank account of Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana through RTGS. Further prayer has been made for directing the official respondents to allow the petitioner Gram Panchayat to use the said grant of Rs.8 lakhs, which was given by the previous government for the construction of streets and drains from Gurudwara Sri Chohla Sahib to Gurudwara Sri Haweli Sahib and allow the Gram Panchayat to spend the said grant as per the prescribed procedure and further to allow the Gram Panchayat to execute development work under the RDF grant as respondent No.4 only under the influence of respondent No.5 is not

allowing the Gram Panchayat to use the said grant and the said act and conduct of respondent No.4 is causing irreparable loss to the development work of the village.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that grievance of the petitioner has already been redressed, therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the same, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
