SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India and under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners by providing adequate protection to the petitioners and also directing the respondents No.8 to 11 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.3 to look into the representation dated 25.05.2023 (Annexure P-7), within a time bound manner.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e., Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Muktsar Sahib to look into the representation dated 25.05.2023 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks with a copy of order so passed supplied to the petitioner.

Ordered accordingly.

However, the aforesaid order will be subject to the undertaking given by Learned counsel for the petitioner that a copy of the present petition will be served upon the learned State counsel during the course of the day.
