1. This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 5 to 12.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Zorawar Singh Chauhan, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 4.

4. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2- Additional Director General of Police, Hisar, Range Hisar to consider and decide the representation dated 16.05.2023 (Annexure P-9) alleged to have been submitted by petitioner No. 2.

5. Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a

speaking order, preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of

certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioners.

6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
