Petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 04.07.2014, Annexure P-4, vide which, services of the petitioner, who is temporary employee of respondent No.2, has been terminated w.e.f. 11.07.2014 and are sought to be replaced by temporary arrangements.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in view that the salary is now being paid under the Rural Health Scheme, nothing survives in the petition. He submits that the petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, in case, petitioner is still left with any grievance, he may approach the Court again by filing a fresh writ petition.
