Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to open the lock of the public park in front of Sondhi Investments, Near Fauji Market, Guru Nanakpura, Civil Lines, Ludhiana which has been illegally locked by respondent No.2 and for the issuance of a writ in the nature of prohibition preventing the respondents from depriving the members of public to enjoy free ingress and free access to the public park on all days at all hours and the park be maintained in a proper manner.

Notice of motion was issued on 01.07.2019 and in pursuance to the same, respondents have appeared and filed their respective replies.

The precise objections raised by learned counsel for the petitioner that the gates of the park, which is for the public at large, are

intentionally being closed during the day time and they are hardly opened in the morning and in the evening.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 had sought some time to seek instructions. He, on instructions, has fairly submitted that the park has two gates and both would remain open through out the day according to the time fixed by respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has expressed his satisfaction in view of the submissions made by learned counsel for respondent No.2.

The present petition stands disposed of in view of the undertaking given by learned counsel for respondent No.2 that the gates of park would remain open through out the day as per the time fixed.
