Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.136, dated 04.03.2023, registered under Sections 177, 193, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC (Section 511 of IPC added later on), at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala.

As per the allegations, petitioner impersonated as Puneet and tried to stand as surety for Tarun in a criminal case and produced fake documents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that case is triable by the Magistrate; that challan has already been filed; and that the trial may take time to conclude, so the petitioner be allowed bail.

Learned State counsel concedes that petitioner has no criminal antecedent and case in question is triable by the Magistrate.

Custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel reveals that the petitioner is in custody for the last 05 months and 10 days. The Trial may take time to conclude. No useful purpose would be served to detain the petitioner in custody.

Having regard to the aforesaid factual position, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
