The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to receive/accept the balance 15% amount due to be paid by the petitioner to respondents in lieu of allotment of Booth No.29 vide allotment letter dated 20.04.2023 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel submits that representations (Annexures P-4/A, P-6, P-8 and P-9) dated 24.04.2023, 04.05.2023, 03.05.2023 and 04.05.2023 respectively were also made to respondents No.2 and 3, however, they had proved to be in vain. He submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the above representations are looked into by respondents No.2 & 3 and decided in accordance with law at the earliest.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Rohit Ahuja, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

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In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, respondents No.2 & 3 are directed to look into the representations (Annexures P-4/A, P-6, P-8 and P-9) and decide them expeditiously by passing a speaking order, preferably within 01 month, in accordance with the provisions of law.

The petition stands disposed of.
