1. Through the instant second petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.80 dated 10.08.2019, registered under Section 409 IPC, at Police Station City Zira, District Ferozepur., the first one having been dismissed as withdrawn on 18.02.2020.
2. Affidavit dated 31.08.2023 along with its annexures, already filed in the Registry in compliance of the order dated 03.07.2023 passed by this Court, is taken on record.
3. Vide order dated 03.07.2023, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 03.07.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Anwar Masih, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.
6. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
7. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 03.07.2023 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
